The Center for African American Health is seeking temporary paid summer interns to support our community panel research and evaluation efforts. The ideal candidates will be familiar with the African American Community in Denver and be excited and motivated to outreach at community events. These individuals will collaborate with the Research and Evaluation team to identify and coordinate event outreach and learn about and promote our community panel. As a team, these individuals will participate in community events to engage individuals to enroll in our panel. Ideally, these candidates would be in an undergraduate or master's program, though exceptional High School students will also be considered. A stipend will be available based on selected applicant's experience and time commitment. Ideally this individual will dedicate approximately 10 hours a week during summer 2018, including weekends and evenings, with flexibility to accommodate other commitments.
