



Frequently Asked Questions

1. When and where is the 2017 Destination Health Walk/Run/Learn?

The Destination Health Walk/Run/Learn will take place Saturday, July 22, 2017 in Denver at the City Park Pavilion surrounded by Ferrill Lake and the historic City Park Bandshell. The physical address is 1700 North York Street, Denver CO 80202. On-site registration opens at 7:00 a.m. The warm-up begins at 7:40 a.m. and both the 5K and 1-mile start at 8:00 am. The 100 Yard Kids' Dash starts at 9:15 a.m.

2. Where is parking available?

Parking is available at East High School and the surrounding neighborhoods. There is also parking at The Museum of Nature and Science

3. What else is there to do at the event?

There will be various health information booths for you to visit, and fun activities for the entire family including live entertainment!

4. Are strollers, dogs, or roller blades allowed?

For your safety and the safety of all participants, we ask that those with strollers and baby joggers line up at the END of the race line. **NO roller blades or dogs (or pets)** of any size or age are allowed on the course. Canine companions and service dogs are permitted.

5. How can someone make a donation who will not be able to attend the Walk/Run/Learn?

6. How are the proceeds to the Destination Health Walk distributed?

The proceeds from Destination Health will support the programs and services offered by The Center for African American Health. The Center partners with a wide variety of health-education and health-delivery organizations to develop and provide culturally appropriate health and wellness programs in the community.

7. What happens if the Walk/Run/Learn t-shirt I ordered for a Team member is too small or large for that person - can they exchange it?

Shirts will be distributed based on the size ordered. Please confirm all T-shirt sizes with team members before placing an order. We cannot guarantee the availability of specific shirt sizes for participants registering on event day, but we will do our very best. **We will not exchange worn t-shirts.**

8. What can I do if someone wants to register after the deadline?

Registration is available online until **midnight on July 19, 2017**. After that date, participants can register on race day beginning at 7:00 a.m. **The race day registration fee is \$40.00.**

9. How do I register if I do not have access to the internet?

If you do not have access to the internet:

You may mail or deliver the **fully completed form (one per person)** to the Center for African American Health, 3601 Martin Luther King Jr., Boulevard, Denver, CO 80205. **Incomplete forms cannot be processed.** Make your check payable to CAAH. The **form must be postmarked on or before July 10, 2017.**

10. How do I register my team on-line?

If you are the team captain, you will need to create your team name in the system. Individuals wanting to join your team should find the team name on the drop down menu on the registration site.



If you have team members that do not have access to the internet:

- You may collect the **fully completed** paper registration form and submit an online registration on their behalf.
- You may collect the **fully completed** paper registration and deliver it to the Center for African American Health, 3601 Martin Luther King Jr., Boulevard, Denver, CO 80205. **Incomplete registration forms will not be accepted.**

11. Is it less expensive to register as a team?

Yes. All individuals signing up on a team of four (4) or more people can register at a reduced rate of \$30 per person.

- **Race day team registration fee is \$35 per person.**
- Individual registrations not affiliated with a team are \$35 per person (**\$30 early bird discount is good through June 18th**).
- On race day, all individual registrations will be **\$40 per person.**

12. Is there any limit to how many people I can have on my team?

The sky is the limit! We encourage you to get as many people as possible on your team!

13. When can I pick up the t-shirts and bibs for my team?

You can pick up your team's t-shirts and bibs the day of the event beginning at 7:00am

15. What is a “Gift Registration” and how do I do this?

You are able to purchase a race registration as a gift for someone. Click on the Gift Registration tab on the Race Roster site. Afterwards, select which age group you would like to purchase as a gift or you can select Team Registration. After the checkout process, Race Roster will e-mail you a unique (100% off) code for you to pass along to that special someone.

16. As part of the registration process, there are terms and conditions that I must agree to before finalizing my registration. However, I don’t want to agree to those terms and there is no “opt out” option – how can I still register?

17. What is a “donation as a pledge” and how do I do this?

You can make a pledge on behalf of an existing registered participant. Click on ‘Pledge Participant’ on the Race Roster website. Select the name of the participant and the enter the amount that you would like to pledge. Anyone can make a donation on behalf of a team as well.

18. Are there extra processing fees when I use a credit card to register?

Yes. A service fee applies to all transactions at checkout. **The fees are:** 6.5% +\$1.25 per participant. A 5% fee is taken for donations.
